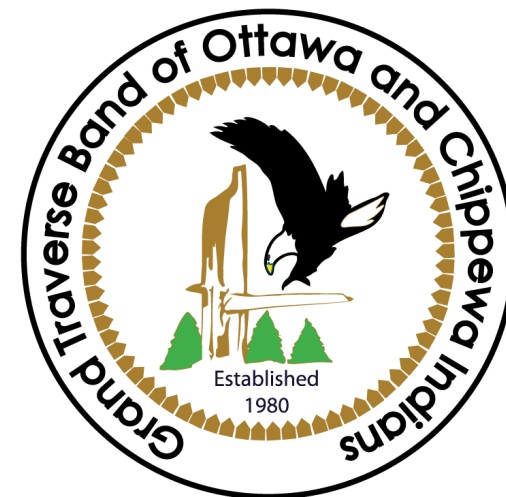

Our services are provided to Grand Traverse Band members and members of other federally-recognized tribes that reside in the six-county service area. The six counties include Leelanau, Grand Traverse, Benzie, Charlevoix, Antrim and Manistee Counties.

The Behavioral Health Program is licensed by the State of Michigan for Substance Abuse and Co-Occurring Disorders Counseling. These services are provided in four locations: Peshawbestown, Traverse City, Benzonia, and Charlevoix.

The role of Behavioral Health is to provide assessment and ongoing outpatient counseling to Tribal Members wishing to make positive life changes.

A contractual psychiatrist is here to provide medication management and psychiatric evaluations for children (12 and older) and adult patients weekly, normally on Tuesdays.

As a culturally integrated treatment program, Traditional Healers provide their services monthly.

All clinical staff possess state licensure and/or drug and alcohol certification in providing their counseling services.
