M-22 resurfacing in Suttons Bay starts May 16

GAYLORD, Mich. - The Michigan Department of Transportation will be investing \$619,000 to resurface M-22 from south of Front Street to south of M-204 and from north of Dumas Road to the north side of Mill Pond Bridge in the Village of Suttons Bay. This project will improve safety

and ride quality for motorists and extend the life of the roadway. County: Leelanau
