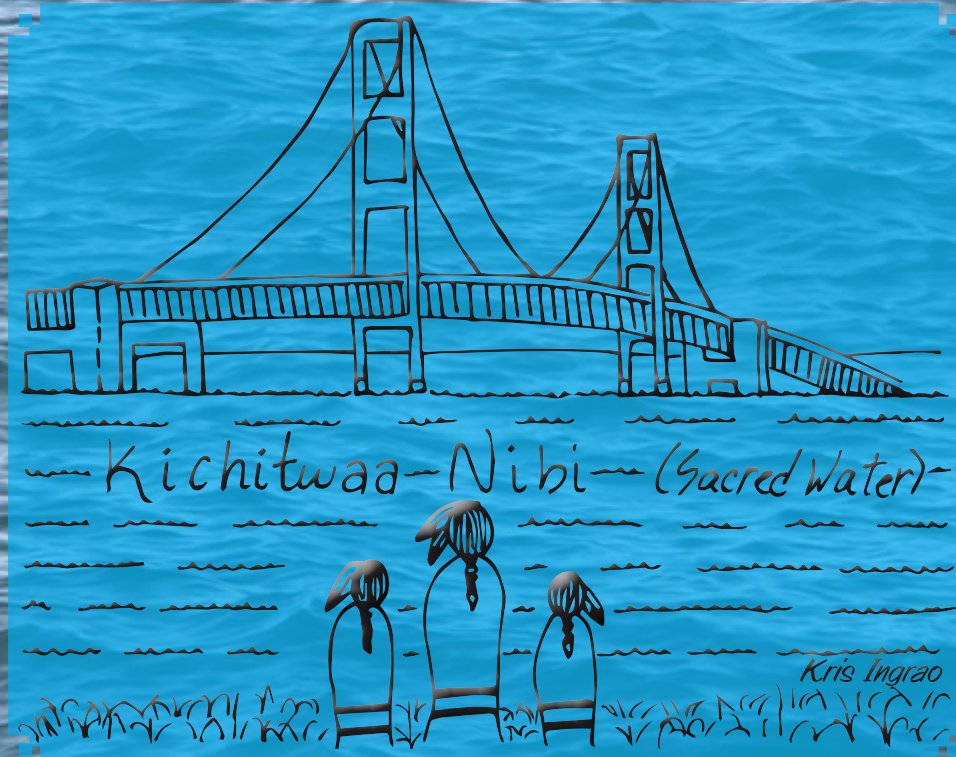

Join the Grand Traverse Band for a gathering to learn how to help shut down the 64-year-old Line 5 oil pipeline in the Straits of Mackinac. Line 5 moves 23 million gallons of crude oil through twin pipelines that sit on the bottom of the Great Lakes for 4.5 miles. University of Michigan scientists have called the Straits “the worst possible place for an oil spill.”

The Grand Traverse Band’s Tribal Council passed a resolution calling on the State of Michigan to decommission Line 5 in 2015.
