A. Motion to File Amicus Brief-*John F. Petoskey, General Counsel*

1. Motion for the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians to file an amicus brief in support of Little Traverse Bay Band v. Whitmer. Little Traverse Bay Band's Motion for a full panel (en banc) hearing at Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals for a decision issued on May 18 holding that the Treaty of 1855 did not create a reservation. The amicus brief principally argues that the Court of Appeals decision is fundamentally wrong in its record recitation of the historical experience of Indian tribes under the 1855 Treaty and that the 1855 Treaty did create a reservation.

B. Motion Authorizing the Legal Department to Request and Negotiate with Leelanau County-*John F. Petoskey, General Counsel*

1. Motion authorizing the Legal Department to request and negotiate with Leelanau County and Sherriff Borkovich to obtain a cross deputized agreement for GTB conservation officers for law enforcement purposes related to conservation. The
